CAMP OBJECTIVES- The main objective of the Joe Taylor football camp is to provide boys of all age's thorough, expert instruction in essential football techniques. The camp is also designed to be a week of fun with additional activities such as swimming, highlight films and guest speakers.

FOOD- A snack will be served at the end of each day

SPECIAL FEATURES- All campers will receive a t-shirt and certificate. An outstanding camper from each age group and position will be selected

Groups- Campers will be accepted from ages 7 to graduating high school seniors. The boys will be grouped according to age, size and ability. Each camper should bring shorts, athletic supporter and athletic or football shoes. There will, however, be NO CONTACT.

DATES AND TIMES

The camp will begin June 18 and end June 21. The 7-on-7 passing tournament will take place on June 22nd. Participants will register between 12:00 noon and 1:00 p.m. on June 18th. Camp hours are 1:00 pm until 5:00 pm.
